WELCOME TO THE SIXTH SEASON OF MUSIC AT ST. LUKE'S,

a yearlong series generously supported by the Friends of Music, parishioners, and supporters of St. Luke's Episcopal Church.

Music at St. Luke's is delighted to continue its ongoing partnership with ensemble vim, a chamber music collective whose mission is bringing awareness to the South's rich cultural landscape, focusing on narratives that have been

historically overlooked in the hopes of creating an environment of artistic unity and diversity.

In addition to monthly Choral Evensongs offered by St. Luke's Schola and Adult Choir, Music at St. Luke's is honored to present the consortium world premiere of *Our Wildest Imagining*, a new work by Dominick DiOrio honoring The Rt. Reverend Gene Robinson. Scored for SATB chorus, organ, and brass quintet, the composition's text was compiled by the composer out of words from sermons, stories, and sayings by Bishop Robinson, as well as quotations from Psalm 27. Both Bishop Robinson and the composer will be present for this exciting premiere.

Our annual Chorister Festival in November welcomes Brandon Straub, recently appointed Director of Music at St. Paul's Choir School in Cambridge, MA as this year's guest conductor. December is always filled with beautiful music at St. Luke's. Events to look forward to include the 50th annual Messiah Sing-Along, Advent Lessons and Carols, and the hugely popular Lunchtime Live! series.

In May, our annual Concert for a Cause features internationally acclaimed soprano, Marnie Breckenridge, joined by yours truly at the piano. A favorite among some of the most gifted composers of our time, Breckenridge has been hailed as a "lovely soprano" (*The New York Times*), possessing a voice of "lyrical poignancy and dramatic power" (*The Chicago Tribune*). This year's beneficiary is Midtown Assistance Center, one of St. Luke's oldest community ministries.

St. Luke's is honored to welcome the 60th Annual Conference of the Association of Anglican Musicians between June 7-11, 2026. The Conference's opening Eucharist will feature the premiere of a newly commissioned congregational setting of the Eucharist by Jessica French.

Our season concludes with an exciting organ recital by internationally acclaimed concert organist, Lynne Davis, as part of the Atlanta Summer Organ Festival.
